Ordinance No. 35

An ordinance of the Normandy Fire Protection District establishing Fire lanes on both public and certain private property for ingress and egress for fire equipment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ST. LOUIS COUNTY:

Section 1: The Fire Chief of the Normandy Fire Protection District shall have authority to establish fire lanes both on public, and certain private, property, including shopping centers, for the purpose of providing ingress and egress for fire equipment.

Section 2: When the Fire Chief shall have established such fire lanes as required, he shall from time to time designate same in writing, approved by the Board of Directors of the District, and attached same to this Ordinance.

Section 3: Copies of all designated Fire Lanes, and this Ordinance shall be mailed to the governing bodies of all municipalities in the Normandy Fire Protection District.

Section 4: In all possible instances the police and police Courts of the municipality when such fire lanes or located shall enforce and maintain said fire lanes and their marking lines and "no parking" designations.
