ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING ORDINANCE NUMBER 6, BEING AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING WITHIN TEN FEET OF A FIRE HYDRANT WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Normandy Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri.

SECTION 1: Ordinance number 6 of the Normandy Fire Protection District, which is entitled "An Ordinance Prohibiting Parking within ten feet of a Fire Hydrant Within the Boundaries of the Normandy Fire Protection District," is hereby re-enacted so that it shall continue to read as follows:

SECTION 1: No vehicle shall be parked at any time within ten feet of a fire hydrant within the boundaries of the Normandy Fire Protection District.

SECTION 2: Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than three dollars (\$3.00) nor more than Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)

SECTION 2: This Ordinance being deemed of an emergency nature it shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
