ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE CONTRACTING WITH THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES FOR AN INTERCHANGE OF SERVICE OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF SAID CITY AND THE NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AND PROVIDING THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND METHOD OF SAID INTERCHANGE AND PROVIDING THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND METHOD OF TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT FOR SUCH INTERCHANGE OF COMMON SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the interchange of service of the Normandy Fire Protection District, and the City of St. Charles is deemed desirable for the protection of life and property in the Fire Protection District of Normandy and in the aforesaid City of St. Charles.

WHEREAS, by the provision of Section 70.210 and 70.320 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1959, municipalities may contract and cooperate with each other for a common service and by the provisions of Section 70.370 and 70.380, Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1959, may interchange the service of their Fire Departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF NORMANDY, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Normandy Fire Protection District hereby contracts with the City of St. Charles, said contract with said city to be effective upon the passage and approval of a like ordinance by the legislative body of said city for an interchange of service of the Fire Departments of said city upon the conditions and provisions hereinafter contained.

SECTION 2: The Normandy Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, shall respond to fire alarms on call in any part of said city and the Fire Department of said city shall respond to fire alarms on call in any part of the Normandy Fire Protection District for period commencing October 1, 1973 and this agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated. This agreement may be terminated by either the municipality or fire protection district by the passage of an ordinance so providing by the legislative body of the municipality or the legislative body of the Fire Protection District. Notice of the passage of such ordinance shall be given by written notice to the Chief Officer of the respective parties and the termination shall take effect at sixty (60) days from the date of service of such notice.

SECTION 3: The consideration for the service of the Fire Department of the municipality herein mentioned shall be the service given for the protection of the lives and property in such municipality by the service of the Normandy Fire Protection District and no compensation shall accrue or be paid by said city for the services of the Normandy Fire Protection District.

SECTION 4: Failure to respond or delay in responding to a service call by any party to the contract shall not make the non-responding or delayed party liable with damages as a consequence thereof, to parties to the contract or to third parties normally benefiting from such services.

SECTION 5: Neither the Normandy Fire Protection District nor said municipality shall be liable by reason of this contract to any fireman, official or employee of the other, nor shall any fireman, official or employee of either the Normandy Fire Protection District or said municipality be considered for any purpose a fireman, official or employee of any municipality other than by the one by which he is regularly employed.

SECTION 6: In case of loss or damage to the equipment or property of either the said municipality or the Normandy Fire Protection District while responding to fire alarms, such loss or damage shall be borne by the city or Fire District owning such equipment or property.

SECTION 7: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage as provided by law.
