ORDINANCE NO. 54

AN ORDINANCE
PROHIBITING PERSONS TAMPERING WITH FIRE HYDRANTS
AND RELATED DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. TAMPERING WITH FIRE HYDRANTS - PROHIBITED. -
No person shall tamper with any fire hydrant, fire plug
or other device available for connecting a fire hose to a
water main without obtaining written authority to do so
from fire fighting authorities having jurisdiction in the
area within which said device is located and from the owner
of said device. The word "tamper" shall include, but not
be limited to, the removal of the cap or any other part
of said device; the insertion of any object or material
into said device; the application of any wrench, tool,
implement or other object or material to said device; the
attachment of a hose or any other instrument to said device;
and/or the use of said device in any fashion so as to
permit water to flow therefrom. This section shall not
apply to the owner of said device, the agents and employees
of said owner, and any fire fighting personnel engaged in
any activity related to fire fighting or the maintenance
and operation of fire fighting equipment.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance being deemed of an emergency
nature it shall take effect and be in full force from and
after its passage.
