ORDINANCE NUMBER 76

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM STANDARDS IN TERMS OF PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES IMPLEMENTED BY SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS, WHICH WILL PROVIDE REASONABLE SAFEGUARD FOR LIFE, SAFETY, PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WELFARE AGAINST HAZARDS OF INADEQUATE DEFECTIVE, OR IMPROPER INSTALLATIONS OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY
THE NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Fire Prevention Code Repealed: Ordinance No. 68

Known as the Fire Prevention Code of the Normandy Fire Protection District and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Fire Prevention Code Adopted. Certain documents, three copies of which placed on file in the Office of the Normandy Fire Protection District on September 1990 said copies being marked and designated as the BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code 1990 Eighth Edition, as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., be and is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the Normandy Fire Protection District, for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code, 1990 Eighth Edition, are hereby referred to adopted and make a part thereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, prescribed in this Section of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Jurisdictional Titles. Throughout the BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code, 1990 Edition, wherever the terms "Name of Jurisdiction" or "Local Jurisdiction" appear, it shall be understood to mean "Normandy Fire Protection District" likewise wherever the term "Fire Department" appears, it shall be deemed to mean Normandy Fire Protection District.

Section 5. Saving Clause. That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Fire Prevention Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or

existing under any act or Ordinance hereby repealed, as cited in Section 3; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 6. Validity. If any section, sub-section, provision, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance of the BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code, Eighth Edition, 1990, is, for any reasons held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or of said code, and the Normandy Fire Protection District hereby declares that it would have passed the same, even though such portions so held to be unconstitutional had not been included therein.

Section 7. Violation Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance, or who shall fail to comply with any order issued pursuant to any section thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance having been duly considered and voted upon by the Board of Directors of the Normandy Fire Protection District was duly enacted as an Ordinance of said Fire District on the 3rd day of Oct 1990. The effective date to be thirty (30) days after the enactment of this Ordinance.
