ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, Normandy Fire Protection District of St. Louis County was regularly incorporated by a Decree of the Circuit Court of St. Louis County pursuant to the applicable provisions of Chapter 321 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, and


WHEREAS, Normandy Fire Protection District desires that there be no geographical limitations on the residence of the persons whom it employs, including specifically those certain restrictions set forth in Bill No. 80, Ordinance No. 79, dated February 6, 1991.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF NORMANDY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Bill No. 80, Ordinance No. 79 of the Normandy Fire Protection District dated February 6, 1991 and entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Residency Requirement of Future Employees of Normandy Fire Protection District" is hereby REPEALED and held for naught.
