

An ordinance of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , adopting the 2003 Edition of the **International Fire Code** , regulating and governing the safe guarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage , handling and use of hazardous substances , materials and devices , and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premise in the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri ; providing for the issuance of permits for hazardous uses or operations ; the collection of fees under the existing **Ordinance Number 91 Bill Number 90** .

NOW , THEREFORE , BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , as follows:

SECTION 1 . FIRE PREVENTION CODE REPEALED :

Bill Number 77 , Ordinance Number 76 adopted on October 03, 1990 , adopting the BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code 1990 , Eighth Edition as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International , Inc. , know as the Fire Prevention Code of the Normandy Fire Protection District is hereby repealed in its entirety , and all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict herewith .

SECTION 2 . HANDLING AND STORAGE OF LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GASES REPEALED :

Bill Number 78 , Ordinance Number 77 adopted on October 03, 1990 , adopting the BOCA Basic National Building Code , The BOCA Basic National Fire Prevention Code 1990 , the BOCA Basic National Mechanical Code , and the Appendices thereof Administrators International , Inc. , County Club Hills , Illinois pertaining to the handling and storage of liquefied Petroleum Gases within the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri is hereby repealed in its entirety , and all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3 . SALE AND DISPENSING OF FUELS AND CHEMICALS BY MEANS OF SELF-SERVICE REPEALED :

Bill Number 57 , Ordinance Number 56 adopted on July 07 , 1976 , adopting the National Fire Code , especially Section 7640 entitled " Self - Service Stations " pertaining to the sale and dispensing of gasoline and other fuels and chemicals by means of self - service is hereby repealed in its entirety , and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith .

SECTION 4 . INSTALLATION AND SUPERVISION OF FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEMS REPEALED :

Bill Number 83 , Ordinance Number 82 adopted on April 19 , 1995 , adopting the NFPA 71 and 72 , chapter 35 pertaining to an approved Fire Protection Signaling System and approved Proprietary System is hereby repealed in its entirety , and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith .

SECTION 5 . FIRE PREVENTION CODE ADOPTED :

That a certain document , one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the Fire Chief of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , being marked and designated as the **International Fire Code** , 2003 edition , including Appendix Chapters A through G , (See International Fire Code Section 101.2.1 , 2003 edition) , as published by the International Code Council , be and is hereby adopted as **the Fire Prevention Code** of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , regulating and governing the safe guarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage , handling and use of hazardous substances , materials and devices , and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premise in the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri ; providing for the issuance of permits for hazardous uses or operations ; and each and all regulations ; the collection of fees under the existing **Ordinance Number 91 , Bill Number 90** therefore ; and each and all of the provisions , conditions and terms of such **International Fire Code** , 2003 edition , published by the **International Code Council** , on file in the office of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri are hereby referred to , adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance ; with insertions , deletions and changes , if any , prescribed in Section (7) of this Ordinance .

SECTION 6 . JURISDICTIONAL TITLES :

Section 101.1. Title. These regulations shall be know as the Fire Prevention Code of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , in lieu of the wording in brackets " name of jurisdiction " which is deleted .

Section 103.1. Wherever " Department of Fire Prevention " appears in this code , it shall read " Fire Marshal's Office " .

Section 103.2. Wherever " Code Official " appears in this Code , it shall read " Fire Official " ; the Fire Official is defined as the Fire Chief and the appointed Fire Official is defined as the " Fire Marshal " of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri and wherever " Chief appointing Authority of the Jurisdiction appears in this code , it shall read " The Board of Directors of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri .

SECTION 7 . THE LIMITS IN CERTAIN SECTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS :

Section 109.3. Violation penalties: All persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect , install , alter , repair or do work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the **Fire Official** , or of a permit or certificate used under this code , shall be guilty of a **Class-B Misdemeanor** and subject to the penalties provided for in 3321. Each day that a violation continues after due notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense .

Section 111.4. Failure to comply: All persons acting contrary to this order or removing or mutilating this notice shall be guilty of a **Class-B Misdemeanor** and subject to the penalties provided for in 3321.

SECTION 8 . VALIDITY :

That if any section , sub-section , provision , sentence , clause or phrase of this Ordinance adopting the **International Fire Code** is / are , for any reason(s) , held to be unconstitutional or invalid , such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance and the **International Fire Code** adopted thereby , and , the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri , hereby declares that it would have passed the same even though such portion so held to be unconstitutional had not been included therein , and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance and the **International Fire Code** are declared to be severable.

SECTION 9 . SAVING CLAUSE :

That nothing in this **Ordinance** or in the **Fire Code** hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court , or any rights acquired , or liability incurred , or any cause of action acquired or existing , under any act or Ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section (1) of this Ordinance ; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost , impaired , or affected by this Ordinance .

SECTION 10 . POSTING ORDINANCE :

That the Normandy Fire Protection District's Fire Chief is hereby ordered and directed to cause this Ordinance to be posted at a public place within the District , such as but not necessarily limited to , the public area of the headquarter of said District at 7302 Pasadena Boulevard , Saint Louis , Missouri 63121 .

SECTION 11 . EFFECTIVE DATE :

This **Ordinance Number 93** , **Bill Number 94** having been duly read at three consecutive board meetings and considered and voted upon by the Board of Directors of the Normandy Fire Protection District of Saint Louis County , Missouri was duly enacted as an Ordinance of said District .




